

LEGAL NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of the Borough of Malvern will hold a public hearing to consider and act upon an Ordinance amending the Borough of Malvern Code of Ordinances by repealing Section 32-16.B(2) regarding Death Benefits for the Families of Police Officers Killed in Service. This public hearing and public meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 15, 2009, at 7:30 pm. At the Malvern Borough Hall, 1 E. First Avenue, Malvern, PA 19355.

The full text is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BOROUGH OF MALVERN CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REPEALING SECTION 32-16.B(2) REGARDING DEATH BENEFITS FOR THE FAMILIES OF POLICE OFFICERS KILLED IN SERVICE.

WHEREAS, On October 9, 2009, Governor Rendell signed Act 51 of 2009 into law; and thereby mandated that the monetary benefit paid to the surviving family members of a police officer killed in service shall henceforth be paid by the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, Borough Council, by Ordinance No. 2005-7, amended the Code of Ordinances to provide that the Borough would pay the death benefit;

NOW THEREFORE be it **ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Malvern, Chester County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Chapter 32, Article II, Section 32-16.B. (2) is hereby **REPEALED**.
