The Meeting was called to order at 7:36pm.

Approval of Minutes: July's meeting minutes were approved with correction.

New Business:

- A. Budget – Lynne went over the current budget and plans for 2011. The Commission will need to purchase more Walking Tour brochures this year. Other purchases for the remainder of the year include frames for pictures that hang in the Borough Council Meeting Room and photography costs. Since the magazine subscriptions are costly, a suggestion was made that we ask local residents for donations of local magazines like Chester County Living and PA Magazine.

Updates:

Working on New Book –

- a. Nancy has logged 33 ½ hours since the last meeting. She is currently up to the year 1976. She has another list for Barb R to research.
- b. Nancy's research has shown that as early as the 1840's the women of Malvern raised money when needed.
- c. Mauger-Givnish came looking for old photos. Nancy provided them with copies.
- d. Nancy handed out a copy of an article from the Daily Local dated Aug 22, 2010. This article mentions the \$40,000 grant from the National Park Service's American Battlefield Protection Program.

Old Business:

- A. Fall Fest – The Commission will be represented at the Fall Festival on October 3. Commission members will cover the day as follows:
 - a. Set Up – Deb C will sign in and get our location, bringing the money, table and other display items. Barb R will bring the tent and possibly the display cases and stands for postcards.
