**ARESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MALVERN,
CHESTER COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, DESIGNATING
EMERGENCY SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE BOROUGH OF MALVERN.**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Malvern is responsible under the Borough Code/Township or applicable Municipal Code for the public safety of the residents of the Borough of Malvern; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County of Chester has requested that the Borough of Malvern provide a resolution outlining the methods and agencies chosen to fulfill the public safety needs of the Borough of Malvern for the efficient administration of the integrated emergency communications system of the Chester County Department of Emergency Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Malvern Fire Company will provide fire protection. Malvern Fire Company chooses to use Automatic Vehicle Location services instead of being designated a primary service or chooses a combination of designated primary coverage area and the use of Automatic Vehicle Location services.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Malvern Fire Company Ambulance Service will provide ambulance services; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Malvern Police Department will provide full time police protection; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED the Malvern Fire Company will provide rescue service; and,

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that Malvern Fire Company Ambulance Service will provide Advanced Life Support Services; and,


FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that Kenneth Furlong is designated as Emergency Management Coordinator; and

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough Council of the Borough of Malvern have reviewed and revised, if necessary, and adopted Emergency Operations Plan of the Borough of Malvern; and has reviewed and adopted the National Incident Management System as a common operating practice.

AND FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, the contact person(s) between said organizations and the Chester County Department of Emergency Services shall be Louis Marcelli, Chief of Police, Malvern Police Department.


