A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MALVERN, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING A REVISION TO THE OFFICIAL ACT 537 PLAN OF EAST WHITELAND TOWNSHIP, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the act of January 24 1966, P.L. 1535, No 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act", as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, require municipalities to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of water and/or environmental health hazards with sewage waste, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, East Whiteland Township has prepared a plan supplement entitled "Act 537 Special Study Transfer of Sanitary Sewerage Facilities" dated April 2022 (the "Special Study"), which includes sewerage facilities which provide service to portions of Malvern Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Special Study was developed to address the Department's planning requirements for the sale of public sewerage system to a private entity, Aqua Pennsylvania Wastewater, Inc. Topics covered include previous wastewater planning, description and graphical mapping of the existing assets being transferred in relation to municipal boundaries and physical characteristics, addressing future growth needs, evaluation of alternatives, institutional evaluation, and a description of the legal and administrative activities to support the implementation of the asset transfer and future ongoing operation and maintenance of the transferred assets, and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Malvern finds that the Special Study described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Malvern hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the municipality, the above referenced Special Study. The Municipality hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said Special Study as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended).
