### King Street Tree Planting Project

## The Following is an update from Dan Daley regarding the King Street Planting Project

- Dan Daley contacted the majority of the owners and is currently awaiting responses.
  Subsequently he will then coordinate a site visit and / or approval from them for the plantings.
- Dan is meeting with a resident on Karen Drive to discuss tree plantings.
- The Malvern Crossing Apartments have a new owner. Dan will contact the new owner and coordinate to meet.
- Dan spoke to the landscaper- Mark from Beechwood Landscaping. He noted that we are okay with this planting season. Additionally that there is availability of trees right now at the nurseries and there is no concern about getting them. Watering will be required and they will try to get the owners to agree to water the trees. For rental properties, they may not be feasible and may need the Borough Public Works to complete the watering/ add utility water bags on the trees.
