7. <u>ORDINANCE NO. 2019 – 8: AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 200 (VEHICLES &</u> <u>TRAFFIC) OF THE MALVERN BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES</u>

• <u>PUBLIC HEARING</u>: Council President Grossman announces that Borough Council will now open a public hearing to consider Ordinance No. 2019 – 8. This ordinance would amend Chapter 200 of the Malvern Borough Code of Ordinances pertaining to vehicles and traffic. The proposed ordinance would prohibit left-hand turns off of Griffith Avenue on to King Street, establish the intersection of Sugartown Road and Monument Avenue as an all-way stop intersection, and prohibit parking on both sides of Church Street from the north side of the intersection with Second Avenue for a distance of 30 feet._The proposed ordinance was advertised in the August 13, 2019 edition of the Daily Local News, as required, and posted on the Borough website.
